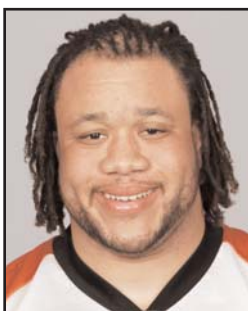

- Tied his career-high with a season-best eight solo tackles vs. Philadelphia 12/23.

2006: Played in all 16 games with five starts...produced 52 tackles, 10 passes defended and an interception...played in two games in the postseason...tallied two tackles in the postseason and two passes defended.

- Tallied four tackles vs. Tampa Bay 10/8...made a key block on Reggie Bush's 65-yard game-winning punt return in the fourth quarter.
- Made a season-high eight tackles and season-best four passes defended vs. Atlanta 11/26.
- Made an interception and four tackles in start at Dallas 12/10.
- Recorded a pass defended and one tackle in NFC Division Playoff game vs. Philadelphia 1/13/07.

- All-SEC first-team selection in 2005 after rushing for 1,242 yards, the sixth-best total in Crimson Tide history.
- Earned second-team All-SEC honors from the *Associated Press* as a sophomore in 2004...played in 12 games with five starts, rushing for 1,062 yards with a career-high eight touchdowns.

JUNIOR (2006): Played in 12 games and started the Bowling Green game at sam linebacker and collected 18 tackles on the season.

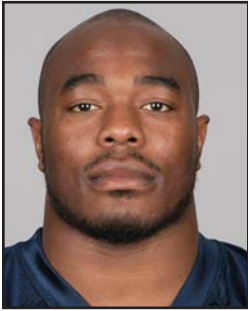
- Blocked a punt in the win at Northwestern and recovered it nine yards down the field.

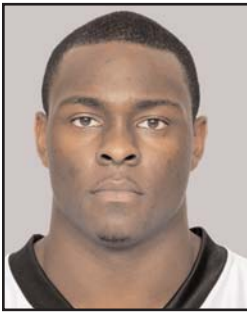

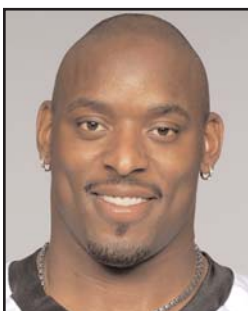

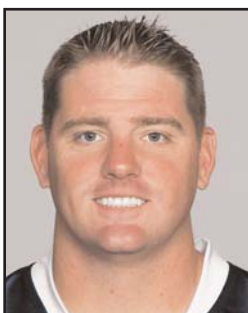
